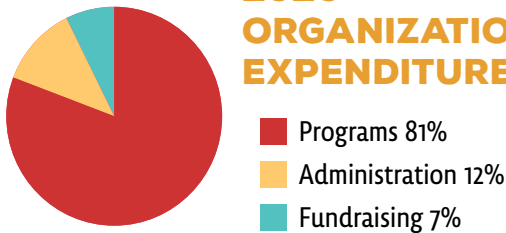
# Financial Overview

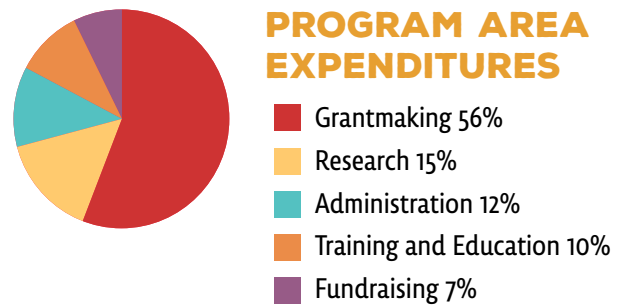
## NEWMEXICOWOMEN.ORG TOTAL END OF YEAR ASSETS 2018-2020

## NEWMEXICOWOMEN.ORG HAS:

**Prioritized** operational and multi-year grant funding for organizations serving women and girls, and has deepened long-term relationships with our grantee partners.

**Produced** three statewide reports highlighting issues impacting self-identified women and girls.

**Influenced** the narrative on gender justice, particularly where it intersects with race, class, and health, through our trainings and communications campaigns.

**Convened** statewide anti-oppression dialogues and fundraising trainings.

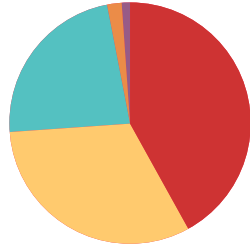
**Research:** NMW.O’s research draws public attention to the issues impacting self-identified women and girls of color in order to influence policy and philanthropy, and support community organizations with data relevant to their work.

**Grantmaking:** NMW.O’s grantmaking areas are gender justice and healing, adolescent girls of color, healthy masculinities, healing and self-care, and a Covid emergency response fund. We prioritize organizations led by or serving self-identifying women and girls of color, transgender and gender non-conforming folks, and immigrant, low-income and rural communities.

**Training and Education:** NMW.O is committed to educating and learning with donors about the intersectional impacts of racial injustice, gender inequity, and historical trauma. We have offered trainings around gender justice and anti-racism to community partners. Further, as part of a statewide Healthy Masculinities Collaborative, we are addressing patriarchy and toxic masculinity.
